**State of Michigan Report:** Lance Ash, State Electrical Chief, Reported on changes at the Bureau. Andrew Brisbo is the new Director and Keith Lambert is the deputy Director. The Energy Code is getting closer to moving to JCAR. The State plans to open the rule set of the 2023 Michigan Electrical Code adoption process. The MRC Public comment process has closed, and they will be reviewing those comments this month. SB-363 and HB 5055 have not moved forward. The PA 407 Rules and still in the process. MRC Comments 76 total and 49 to remove the electrical requirements and use the MEC instead. It is very important that our members show up and any public hearings.

**Unfinished Business:** A motion by Chris Cleveland seconded by John Stoudt to continue the secretary compensation at \$3,500.00 and covering his hotel accommodations. **The Motion Carried.**

**New Business:** A motion by Tom Bowes seconded by Scott Weaver to sponsor the Michigan Skills USA competition with a donation of \$2,500.00. **The Motion Carried.**


**Announcements:** There were no announcements.
