Previous Minutes: David Williams, Secretary, presented the Minutes of the March 1, 2023 Board of Directors meeting. Grace Trudell made a motion to approve the minutes as presented, seconded by Bert Gale. **The Motion Carried.**

Correspondence: Discussion a meeting survey regarding a comment about having weapons in the meeting or hospitality rooms.

Treasurers Report: Treasurer, Scott Weaver. The financial reports provided by Treasurer Weaver were reviewed by the Board. The account balance as of June 14, 2023, was \$118,733.21. The check register and the Visa monthly purchases were also reviewed. There was a motion to approve the treasurers report by Grace Trudell and seconded by Barri Woods. **The Motion Carried.**

Standing Committee Reports:

Education Committee: Brian Carter, Education Chair reported on the registration of programs with the state and the use of EventBrite at our meetings.

Summer Meeting Program, Chair Don Iverson reported all the speakers are as listed in the program. We have some great speakers and a great attendance for this meeting.

Summer Guests Program, Chair Bert Gale will be working on that program.

Annual Meeting Program, Chair, Don Iverson, reported on the tentative program. We are hoping for a code update but making alternate plans as well. Possible programs Fault Managed Power, Energy Storage, and a couple other programs.

Annual Guests Program, Chair, Gert Gale, will be discussing the Guest Program activities with the group.

Audit Committee: Chair, John Stoudt, reported on the Audit that was conducted on April 27, 2023. The beginning balance in 2022 was \$114,016.00 and ending balance of \$132,619.00. The total receipts of 482,671.00 and total expenses of \$64,068.00. Total profit of \$18,603.00. The 2022 Audit Report, Financial Position and tax returns were sent to the IAEI and The Western Section.

Budget Committee: Chair, Chris Blackburn, reported that he will be working with Scott Weaver to develop the budget.

By-Laws and Policy Committee: Chair, Tom Bowes, had no report.

Inspector School Committee: Chair, Scott Weaver, The Inspectors School is being planned for January 10-12, 2024 at the NECA facility in Troy, Michigan.

Legislative Committee: Chair, Tom Bowes, reported SB 36 and HB 4014. SB 36 has a lot of concerns for the electrical industry and needs further review.

Meeting Location Committee: Chair, Bert Gale, Don Iverson moved to have the 2024 Spring Meeting at the Comfort Inns and Suites in Mt. Pleasant February 29-March 1 Room Rate \$109.00 Seconded by Scott Weaver. **The Motion Carried.** Beau Burton suggested on reviewing a 3 year option. A motion by Scott Weaver to have the 2024 Summer Meeting at the Doubletree Hotel in Bay City and for 2025 and 2026 Room Rate \$125.00. Seconded by Pat Falzon. **The Motion Carried.**

State of Michigan Report: Lance Ash, State Electrical Chief,

The draft for the 2023 Michigan Electrical Code is completed. The draft is going through the final review before we schedule the public hearing.

We estimate the public hearing for the 2023 Michigan Electrical Code will be sometime in August and the public hearing for the 2021 Michigan Energy Code and the 2021 Michigan Residential Code will be sometime in September.

It is still our goal to have the codes submitted to JCAR by October of this year.

The Skilled Trades Regulation Rules under 2016 PA 407 went into effect May 3rd, 2023.

The ruleset is posted on our website www.michigan.gov/bcc

License renewals submitted 60 days after expiration are subject to a \$100 late renewal fee.

Exams are now required for each registration to become a code official, inspector, and plan reviewer.

Exams will be conducted by our third-party vendor, PSI, and we are working with them on an implementation date.

Once the exams implementation date has been established with PSI, another notification will be provided with details.

Meeting Registration Report: Brian Carter reported the registration count for the Summer 2023 Meeting is 158 attendees and 11 guests. The final attendance was 147 attendees and 3 guests.

NFPA Electrical Inspector Section: Tim McClintock, Provided information regarding the NFPA Electrical Inspector Section including two Michigan Chapter IAEI Members being recommended to serve on the NEC Code Panel. Being Lance Ash, CMP-1 and AJ Libby CMP-2.

Unfinished Business: The Bylaw and Policy Committee was asked to develop a record retention policy for the chapter documents and records.


